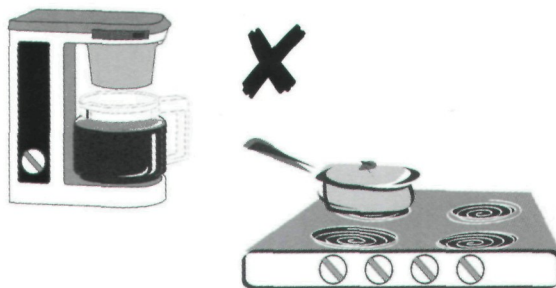




Can I place my pantry within the airconditioned space?

Any heat-generating objects (that themselves do not need airconditioning) are best avoided within the conditioned space. The more the heat generated, the more the airconditioning required, hence larger power bills! A pantry would certainly generate heat with its electric stoves, coffee makers and water-coolers. Ideally, place it outside the conditioned area.



Are there any other 'heat-producing' objects that can similarly go outside the airconditioned space?

Equipment that produce heat and can possibly be kept out of the conditioned space are photocopying machines, stabilisers, UPS and electronic power inverters.

Some of these equipment may work well outside conditioned space, but may need adequate ventilation. Some large ones, however, may themselves need airconditioning to operate efficiently. It is best therefore to consult the manufacturer of each such equipment before deciding on placing them inside or outside the airconditioned space.
